For the Academic year 16/17, the funding continued to be used to employ a qualified PE teacher (on an agency basis) to assist in the development of the delivery of PE lessons by Foley staff, and to run a weekly after school club in different PE disciplines.

The strategy has been continued to ensure continually improving skills, knowledge and teaching abilities of the staff, and the learning for both the current pupils and future cohorts.

However, it is planned that the focus of the PE & Sports Premium spend will change in the academic year 17/18. Having used the previous three years' funding to develop the skills base and knowledge of the school staff, we have decided to change the focus to increasing pupils' participation in sports competitions, festivals and extra-curricular sports clubs, including those taking place at lunch time.

By using the funding in this way in the academic year 17/18, we will release a member of existing staff from part of their current teaching commitments, to increase the number and range of extra-curricular sports and physical activity clubs provided.

We will also aim to deliver a wider range of activities to add variety to extra-curricular provision and to encourage participation of a greater number of pupils
